<b>Meetings</b> National, Regional & Unit	#1 & 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>KVA Blazer w/accoutrements maximum 2 pins on left lapel or Blazer or jacket.</li> <li>No regimental collar badges to be worn on the blazer or shirt.</li> </ul> <p><b>WHEN IN WINTER DRESS:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The light green long sleeved shirt, KVA tie, Beret with Regimental, or Corps Cap badge of the Unit served while in Korea.</li> <li>Wings or other awards (helicopter pilot etc, will be worn above the KVA crest &amp; pocket and above the Medals.</li> </ul> <p># 2 Dress is as above without Medals and Awards may be worn at Meetings, at the discretion of the President</p>	<b>Name Tags:</b>  To be worn above Association Medals on right side of Blazer
<b>Parades, Funerals &amp; Remembrance Services</b>	#1 & 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>As per note # with large campaign medals , worn on the left breast, above the pocket</li> <li>KVA Medals worn on the right breast of the blazer, in line with the Campaign Medals, KVA medals are not to be mixed with other unauthorized medals or Military Medals.</li> <li>Only the Unit, Regional &amp; National Sgt at Arms will wear appropriate badges of Appointment and they and the colour Parties come under the direction of National Sgt at Arms.</li> <li>Poppies should be worn on the left lapel of the Blazer, when on those Special occasions.</li> </ul>	<b>Note:</b>  Pace sticks or drill canes, are not to be carried in the funeral home.  May be carried if in charge of Funeral at grave Site.
<b>Cocktail parties Dinners Receptions, etc</b>	# 1 - 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>As per # 1 dress, with miniature medals, (if in possession of said medals) worn same as above, White shirt maybe worn, with forest green cummerbund, and bow tie, at the members discretion.</li> <li>Large medals may be worn if not in possession of miniature medals</li> </ul>	
<b>Summer dress</b> Detailed 15th May, depending on the climate,  Ending in Sept by the Unit President	#4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Summer dress, white short sleeved shirt with open collar, epaulets, (Campaign ribbons bars), worn parallel above the left breast pocket</li> <li>KVA ribbon bars worn parallel above the right breast pocket, no medals to be worn on the summer dress.</li> <li>Wings citations, Duke of Edinburgh medallion and other awards should be worn in the place above the ribbons etc.</li> <li>25th Brigade collar badge to be worn on the right corner of the right collar, and the Commonwealth collar badge worn on the left corner of the collar, in the military fashion.</li> <li>Unit slip ons will be worn on the epaulet, with the Unit designation and with KVA and CANADA inscribed on the slip ons</li> <li>Poppies should be worn on the left lapel of the Blazer, when on those Special occasions</li> </ul>	
Work Parties	#5	Miscellaneous dress may include various crest on wind breaker, jackets etc. Ball caps at the members discretion at various non formal Functions
